**Orientation and initial placement testing** are scheduled to take place on the first day of class for all new students. New student orientation takes approximately one hour and initial placement testing takes approximately two hours. Ongoing advising and support are provided to all students by the center director and/or assistant director or other qualified staff as needed.
